Time to Renew Pet Licenses



Help us protect our pets and our people, identify pets running at large, and protect against disease by getting your pet licensed. All cats and dogs over the age of four months must obtain a license. The license fee is \$7.50 per animal and the license is good until June 30, 2016. The owner must provide proof of rabies vaccination before a license can be issued. Licenses must be renewed by June 30, 2014.

On May 9th & 10th the new play equipment, known as "Pier 25 Playland", will be installed in Speaker Park. The name "Pier 25" refers to our historic Stone Piers and the year Speaker Park was founded, 1925. The new equipment has an aquatic theme and celebrates activities on the lake.

This project is a great testament to our community. The cost of Pier 25 Playland is around \$120,000. The City of Lake View has committed \$35,000 to the project but the remainder was raised by the Pier 25 Citizen's Committee through grants and private fundraising. Emerald Ash Borer

The Emerald Ash Borer (EAB) is an invasive pest that attacks and kills ash trees. This insect has been found in many areas in Iowa and it is spreading. The Lake View Park Board has prepared a proactive plan to remove ash trees and replace them with a wide variety of species. The removal of ash trees is proposed to take place over several years. ***The City seeks public input on this proposal.*** The Park Board is hosting a public meeting at **City Hall on Saturday, May 3rd at 9:00 a.m.** to discuss the EAB, options for treatment, and the plan for proactive removal. Aquatic Vegetation Harvester

The City is partnering with the Iowa DNR, the Black Hawk LPA, Sac County, and the LV Community Club to operate an Aquatic Vegetation Harvester on Black Hawk Lake this summer. Delivery date of the machine is sometime in June. The City is hiring two seasonal employees to operate the harvester and dump trucks to haul away the vegetation. During Water Week, take time to fix that leaky faucet. If your faucet is dripping at the rate of one drop per second, you can expect to waste 2700 gallons a year.

Check your toilet tank for leaks. Add food coloring to the tank. If the toilet is leaking, color will appear in the bowl within 30 minutes. A leaky toilet can waste more than 100 gallons/day.
