Lake View Municipal Building

The Lake View City Council met in regular session on Monday, August 1, 2016 at the Lake View Municipal Building. The meeting was called to order by Mayor John Westergaard at 7:00 p.m. Roll call was taken: Present: Councilors Jerry Huss, Tami Moeller, Terry Reis, Ken Steinkamp, and Dave Woltman. Also present: Greg & Nancy Onstot, Lon Buse, Kodi Brotherson, and Marcia Haakenson.

#### Public Forum

Greg Onstot spoke to the Council about the home in Speaker Park which is being sold at public auction. He stated that he and others would like to see the City own that property and use it to enlarge and enhance Speaker Park. He stated that he a group of people may attempt to raise private donations to purchase the property. The Group would then demolish the buildings, restore the site and gift the property to the City. He asked if the City would accept the gift. Although no vote was taken, the Council indicated that they would accept the gift.

#### Lagoon: Sewer Outfall Line

The Public Works Director discussed options for the alignment of the sewer outfall line from the existing sewer plant to the lagoon site. The Council requested more information from the engineer to identify the best and most cost-effective alignment.

#### SRF Sponsored Project

The Council reviewed potential green infrastructure projects which could be funded through the Sponsored Project program. Motion by Moeller, second by Woltman, to Resolution # 16-45: "Resolution Approving the Submission of an SRF Sponsored Project Application." Roll call vote: All ayes. Motion carried.

Annexation Request of Property on the East Side of Black Hawk Lake

The City has received a request from the property owner, Bob Terrell, to annex a parcel of land on the east side of Black Hawk Lake. The City Clerk/Administrator reviewed the annexation process, noting that the property proposed for annexation needs to be contiguous with the existing city limits. No action was taken.

City Clerk/Administrator Report.

The City Clerk/Administrator stated that strong winds this morning damaged many trees. One tree fell on the Library, putting a six inch hole in the roof.

Motion by Moeller, second by Reis, to adjourn. On vote: all ayes. Motion carried.
