The Lake View City Council met in regular session on Monday, February 2, 2015 at the Lake View Municipal Building. The meeting was called to order by Mayor John Westergaard at 7:04 p.m. Roll call was taken: Present: Councilors Jerry Huss, Terry Reis, Ken Steinkamp, and Dave Woltman. Councilor Lynn ØGusö Cleveland participated via conference call. Also present: Erin McCullough, Ted Helmich, Tim Laney, and Marcia Haakenson.

PUBLIC FORUM

Tim Laney spoke with the Council about snow removal, stating that excessive snow was placed on the sidewalk of The Redemption Center. He asked that procedures be developed so that this not happen again.

Sewer Rate Ordinance

Motion by Reis, second by Steinkamp, to approve the third and final reading of **ORDINANCE # 467**: "An Ordinance Amending the Code of the Ordinances of the City of Lake View, Iowa, 2011, by Amending Provisions Pertaining to Sewer Rates." Roll call vote: Ayes: Cleveland, Reis, Steinkamp, Woltman. Nays: Huss. Motion carried.

Operation of ATVØ and UTVØ on City Streets.

Police Chief Ted Helmich spoke with the Council about permitting the operation of ATVØ and UTVØ on City streets. Chief Helmich reviewed the rules recently passed by Sac County and suggested that the City implement similar rules. Motion by Woltman, second by Reis, to instruct the City Clerk/Administrator to prepare an ordinance for Council consideration based on the Sac County regulations. Roll call vote: All ayes. Motion carried.

Hometown Pride

Mayor Westergaard updated the Council on organizational meeting of the County-wide Hometown Pride steering committee. The committee is working through the process to hire a community coach to work with all Sac County Hometown Pride participants. Each participating entities was asked to pay their per-capita contribution for Year One. Motion

by Steinkamp, second by Huss, to approve payment of \$1,142 to SETD for Year One of the Hometown Pride program. Roll call vote: All ayes. Motion carried.

Board of Adjustment Appointments

Motion by Huss, second by Woltman, to appoint Jerry Waldrop to the Board of Adjustment for a term expiring February 28, 2019, and Leeann Davis for a term expiring February 28, 2020. Roll call vote: All ayes. Motion carried.

City Clerk/Administrator Report

Pick-up Bids: City staff is obtaining quotes for three new pick-ups. The Council stated that they would like to see competitive quotes from local dealers prior to possible consideration of the state bid.

Mass Notification System: The City Clerk/Administrator reviewed the "Alert Iowa" mass emergency notification system and reviewed the process for people to sign up for the system.

Motion by Reis, second by Cleveland, to adjourn. On vote: all ayes. Motion carried.
