To change your name on a Delta SkyMiles account and/or ticket after marriage, log in to your Delta account and submit a request via the Identity Verification Form, providing a copy of your marriage certificate and updated legal identification.

Can I transfer a Delta airline ticket to someone else?

No, you generally cannot transfer a purchased Delta air ticket to another person because Delta tickets are non-transferable and only valid for the named passenger. However, if you cancel a non-refundable ticket within the 24-hour risk-free cancellation period or before departure (often incurring a fee), you may be able to get an eCredit that can be used for future travel. For other situations, you might be able to transfer SkyMiles to another person's account or book a flight for someone else using miles, but the ticket itself is for the named passenger.

How much is the change fee for Delta?

Delta's flight change fees depend on your origin, ticket type, and loyalty status. For tickets originating in the U.S. and Canada, there are no change fees for Main Cabin and above fares, but the Basic Economy fare is non-refundable and non-changeable in most cases, though you may receive an eCredit minus a fee.
